The successful candidate will be expected to develop a strong, independent, high-impact research program that enhances or complements existing plasma/fusion research efforts in the Department. The candidate will be expected to perform instruction, scholarly research, and service duties. Classroom and individual instruction and supervision of graduate thesis research are required.
